Native Awareness. The Native liaison office offers a wide variety of services including drumming groups, talking circles, sweat lodge, guidance through visits with elders and other programs.

The Separate School Board offers High school credits in a classroom setting.

Anger Management. A 6-session program offered in a group setting and one on one in some circumstances.

Women's issues programs are offered through Elizabeth Fry.

Discharge planning assistance is offered to individuals through the programs office and through different attending agencies (Elizabeth Fry, John Howard, Canadian Mental Health Association - to name a few)
